- A tendency to think and act spontaneously rather than fears based on past experiences
- A loss of interest interpreting the actions of others.
- Frequent, overwhelming episodes of appreciation.
- An unmistakable ability to enjoy each moment.
- A loss of interest in conflict.
- Contented feelings of connectedness with others and nature.
- A loss of interest in judging other people.
- A loss of ability to worry.
- Frequent attacks of smiling.
- An increased susceptibility to the love extended by others as well as the uncontrollable urge to extend it.
